 - USGS Lidar Project Update, by Mr. Chris Cretini.
 Overview of USGS Lidar Project in Arkansas. When completed, the entire state will be covered at level 2 quality lidar data.
 - Digital Orthoimagery Update, by Mr. Shelby Johnson
 Presented data representing a 99% acquisition of the state. Reflights were
 done due to flooding and clouds. Waiting on additional reflights, but the
 acquisition process is near to completion.
 - 94th General Assembly Update, by Mr. Shelby Johnson
 <u>HB 1110</u> eliminates obsolete mapping of fire and police districts.

HB 1163 requires survey for deeds to submerged lands.

<u>HB 1328</u> repeals reporting requirements to Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information. The Board voted to repeal this reporting requirement at the December meeting.

<u>HB 1350</u> is related to redistricting as it pertains to school board elections with a population of 10% or greater minority population, and a population of 8000 or more.

<u>HB 287</u> requires plat creator to submit plats to a city planning commission prior to being filed with the county clerk's office.
