DATA AND TRANSPARENCY PANEL (DTP)

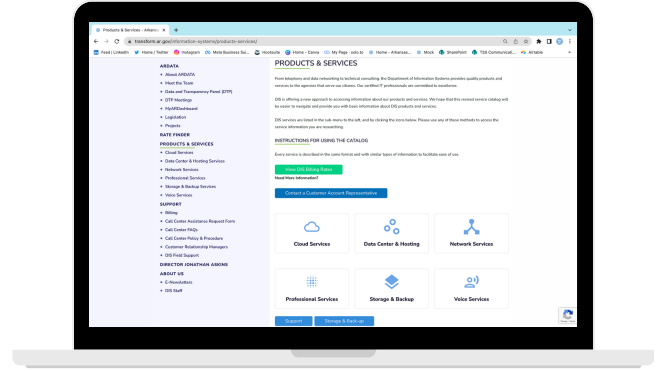

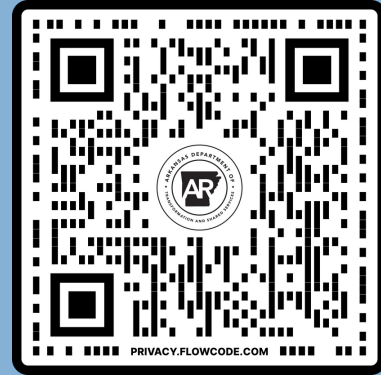
