SUBJECT: Law Enforcement Insignia Sales

Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-77-202 prohibits the sale of law enforcement insignia to any person other than a law enforcement officer or an appointed auxiliary law enforcement officer.

Before purchasing any law enforcement insignia items, individuals must present one of the following acceptable forms of identification as prescribed by the Arkansas State Police.

Authorized purchasers of blue lights and blue lens caps shall be limited to the following:

Law Enforcement Officers and Appointed Auxiliary Law Enforcement Officers:

1. A photo identification card issued by the agency employing the officer verifying current employment of the officer.
2. A notarized letter on letterhead of the agency employing the officer, signed by the administrative head, that verifies the officer's current employment. This letter must be accompanied by the officer's current Arkansas driver's license.

No other form of identification shall be accepted.

The identification will be copied and attached to the receipt of the item purchased.

The Marketing and Redistribution personnel will report each sale of law enforcement insignia as described in Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-77-202 no later than ten (10) business days after the sale is concluded.

Each sale of law enforcement insignia, as described in Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-77-202, shall be reported on form ASP-45 as prescribed by the Arkansas State Police and submitted to the address as stated on the form.
