Arkansas Health and Opportunity for Me (ARHOME)

- Arkansas's Medicaid expansion program under the federal Affordable Care Act.
- Formerly known as Arkansas Works
- Serves adults:
 - ✓ Between 19 and 64 years old
 - ✓ With household income below 138% FPL
- Federal government pays 90%; Arkansas pays 10%



Arkansas Health and Opportunity for Me (ARHOME)

- Established as a Medicaid waiver program
- Uses Medicaid dollars to buy private insurance for clients
- Act 530 of 2021 created ARHOME to replace Arkansas Works
- Federal government (CMS) approved new waiver in December 2021, for January 1, 2022, start



Current ARHOME Population

- More than 336,000 people are currently enrolled in ARHOME.
- About 20% of Arkansas's non-elderly adults receive health coverage through ARHOME.
- SFY 2021 expenditures totaled \$2.46 billion.

ARHOME aims to improve health through focusing on Social Determinants of Health


Goal is to use cross-agency information to address the whole person's needs

- Educational opportunities



Participated in Employment, Employment Training, or Post-Secondary Education Anytime in CY 2020




ARHOME Employment

Employed Anytime in CY 2020













ARHOME Amount of Service Use


Claims Per Person Per Year CY 2017-2020



ARHOME Enrollment by Age




ARHOME Enrollees by County




ARHOME Enrollment by Federal Poverty Level


ARHOME Enrollment by FPL Band




ARHOME Enrollment by Race and Ethnicity






ARHOME Enrollees by Household Size



ARHOME Enrollees With Dependent Child




ARHOME Enrollees, Formerly Incarcerated, CY2020


